- Able to print proof sheets to check press set-up, registration, ink viscosity, and color
- Able to receive approval from Lead Operator following press set-up samples and production run
- Able to print jobs while maintaining optimum production rate, color density, registration, and quality standard within company guidelines
- Able to monitor equipment during job runs and remain alert to mechanical problems
- Able to communicate job status and Quality Control issues (QC) with Shop Production Manager/Lead/Apprentice
- Confidence in troubleshooting press or print-related issues and problem solve solutions
- Capable of making print adjustments to maintain print quality, registration, color, and production speed
- Capable of setting the dryer for proper drying
- Able to load and offload (rack) pieces with an emphasis on Quality Control (QC)
- To perform routine equipment maintenance and upkeep following guidelines set forth by the company
- Able to direct the work of a Racker
- Able to train production press operators on new printing techniques
- Willing to be assigned other duties as required by management
- Experience in screen prep: coating, exposing, and reclaiming
- Experience in screens: stretching and gluing

- Operate industrial paper cutter to cut down jobs to exact specifications
